Grade 12 Reportable w/out essay (for Bright Futures) – April 13  
Grade 12 NON-reportable with 50% extra time (for concordant score): April 26

ACT SCHOOL DAY

All Types of Tests (reportable and non-reportable): March 8 (makeup day March 29)

The ACT school day will target three very specific groups ONLY

- Grade 12 Students needing a concordant/comparative score (non-reportable)
- **At-RISK** Grade 11 Students that have not yet received a qualifying score and are in need of the extra opportunity (non-reportable)
- VOLUNTEER ONLY Grade 12 Students needing a qualifying Bright Futures score (reportable)

The ACT School Day opportunity is **NOT** for Grade 11 students on track to graduate or can reasonably be expected to pass an upcoming administration of the ELA Retake/School Day SAT/ACT – this is what the Grade 11 SAT School day is used for.
