

## CHECK LIST FOR VOICES SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Voices for the Florida Keys Children awards Scholarships for up to \$2000.00 for each Semester or professional program you are participating in.

To qualify you must demonstrate a financial need, The Carol Parker Scholarship Fund was established in 2003 to improve the lives of individuals who have been involved with a Guardian ad Litem or are otherwise in need.

USE THE FOLLOWING AS A CHECKLIST: (Scholarships will not be considered without the additional information listed below. The essay can be mailed or E-Mailed along with your application.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. You must supply to the Scholarship Committee a copy of your high school diploma or GED.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. You must provide an acceptance letter from the educational facility you are planning to attend. If you are reapplying, you must send your grades for the semester prior to the semester for which you are applying and, if changing schools, include an acceptance letter.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Include your essay (about yourself, educational goals, and how this scholarship will help you) On a separate sheet of paper.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Two letters of recommendation. This can be from a teacher, administrator, coach, court appointed guardian, Mentor, etc., i.e., someone who knows you well.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Your High School transcripts. (If reapplying for the Scholarship please send your prior collegiate grades and a copy of your current official class registration).
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Any other information you feel is pertinent to you being considered for this Scholarship. (Extracurricular activities i.e., Awards, Clubs, volunteer activities, band, sports, etc.)

Scholarships may be given to older students as age is not a consideration. You must have 12 credit hours or more and a minimum 2.0 GPA to be considered for funding for the following semester.

A Voices for Florida Keys Children (VFFKC) scholarship representative will be assigned to mentor awardee and monitor usage of funds awarded. The recipient will be required to communicate with the mentor/representative and supply documentation as to usage of funds.
