





**Retake Policy** 

If you purchased a picture package that you are unhappy with, due to photographer error, the retake is free of charge. A photographer error would include pictures that are too dark, washed out, or incorrectly cropped.

If you are unhappy due to other issues that are not a photographer error, a \$15 fee will be charged. These may include, but not limited to, issues such as a bad hair day, or a student being unhappy with a smile. No form is needed for the retake, but students must return the original photo prints to the photographer at the time of the retake. Include printed copy of Retake Fee Receipt.


## Congratulations!

You can pay Ms. Patricia in the front office and she will notify us and we will deliver to you.



Dear 6th grade Parents,

The Florida Department of Health-Monroe will be offering several school based vaccine clinics in your child's school for the 6th grade class (only).

Your child is REQUIRED to have a <u>Tdap</u> vaccine booster <u>prior</u> to entry into the 7<sup>th</sup> grade. We will offer this vaccine in the school vaccine clinic. Attached is a flyer (VIS) with a description of this required vaccine.

\*your child will not be able to start 7<sup>th</sup> grade without the REQUIRED <u>Tdap</u> vaccine.

Additionally, in these school vaccine clinics we will offer highly recommended vaccines, to include; HPV (male and female, 2 dose series), Hepatitis A (2 dose series), Menactra, and Flu. Attached is a flyer (VIS) with a description for each of these vaccines.

Please review the attached forms. If your child has not already received their required Tdap and you are interested in having your child get their vaccines in the school based vaccine clinic, please fill out the attached permission slip and return it to your school nurse. You do not need to be present for your child to get vaccinated.

There is <u>never</u> an out-of-pocket cost for children's vaccines at our health department clinics. If you have insurance that covers vaccines, we will bill the insurance company directly. If you do not have insurance, we have a program that will cover the cost of your child's vaccines.

Thank you in advance for your attention to this important matter. We encourage you to take advantage of this offer to assure your child is in compliance and healthy.
