The list below shows how dedicated our student-athletes and coaches are to their programs and our athletic department. For a small town, we sure give the state a good run every year! We are very proud of everyone.

Wrestling – Caleb Ashe placed 2^{nd} and Jayden Glover placed 6^{th} in the state, 6 advanced to States, Placed 3^{rd} as a team at Regionals, Regional Champion – Aaron Palacios, 13 advanced to Regionals, and District Champions – 7^{th} Straight, 7 individual district titles
