## COVID-19 FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF OF MONROE COUNTY SCHOOLS

The protocols are included here for quick reference:

### STUDENTS:

- If exposed to a positive individual, can continue to go to school as long as there are **NO** symptoms or may quarantine for up to 7 days. Notify attendance if you choose to stay home to excuse absences.
- If positive:
  - Out for 10 days and can return as long as symptoms are improving and fever free for 24 hours without the use of medications. OR
  - Return at any time with negative lab test and NO symptoms. OR
  - Return with note by a medical provider clearing them to return.

### STAFF:

- If exposed to a positive individual, can continue to go to school as long as there are NO symptoms or may opt to quarantine for up to 10 days.
- If positive:
  - Out for 10 days and can return as long as symptoms are improving and fever free for 24 hours without the use of medications. Reach out to your principal if wanting to return sooner for individual consideration.

## GUIDANCE FOR THE GENERAL POPULATION

The CDC introduced possibly shorter quarantine/isolation periods (5+5 rule) in late December. This is very detailed and determined by your risk factors, vaccination status, job, and willingness to wear a mask.
