*Youth and young adults

*Under age 25 experiencing a behavioral health crisis

*Goal is to provide support in community and avoid Baker Act hospitalization, jail or use of emergency room.

* Available 24/7 through crisis line (305) 434- 7660 Option #8

*Provide on-demand crisis intervention services

*Immediate phone response and on site assessment or support within 60 minutes for those meeting criteria above

*Intensive follow up services and linkage to resources following the crisis
