

Keys AHEC Health Centers have partnered with the Monroe County School District for the past 11 years offering access to on-site School Based Primary Medical Care Services.

All current full-time and part-time staff members are eligible to utilize our Clinical Health Centers for general and basic health care needs. We always encourage patients to have a Primary Care Physician and/or Specialist to care for necessary individual needs.

How it Works:

- To make an appointment, just call 305-743 7111 ext 210.
- Keys AHEC also accepts walk-in visits.
 - Simply just go down to the Health Clinic site at your school on its scheduled day.
 - See our Days and Times as our schedule does rotate over 10 schools each week with 7 medical providers.
 - If the Provider is busy, they will give you a time to return that day or the next.
 - Keys AHEC does require a Patient Registration and Consent Form.
 - These will be provided at the Clinic or can be sent electronically.

- Clinic Hours run ½ hour prior to the start of school to ½ hour after school.

What We Offer:

- Keys AHEC offers access to Primary Care Medical Services:
 - General Sick and Wellness Visits
 - Physicals
 - Diagnosis, Treatment and Prescriptions (as necessary)
 - o Flu, Cold, Strep and Covid-19 Testing and Treatment
 - Glucose Testing
 - Prescription Refills
 - May need your PCP record or proof of prescription (RX Bottle)
 - Pregnancy Testing
 - Assistance w/Management of Chronic Diseases
 - Hypertension
 - Diabetes
 - Obesity/Overweight
 - Referral for Lab and/or Imaging Testing
 - Minor Injuries/Suture Removal
 - Referral for Specialty Care

Things to Know:

- Keys AHEC will never require payment for services, but may bill your Health Insurance.
- There are no co-pays or required deductibles due to Keys AHEC.
- We only accept what is paid by the insurance company. No bill will be sent although you will receive an EOB (Explanation of Benefits) form in the mail by your company.
- Services outside of Keys AHEC that are referred, such as lab services/blood draws, Imaging, prescription fills or referrals to another physician will come with a fee from that provider.
- The Keys AHEC Health Centers have 7 Nurse Practitioners (APRNs) serving 10 Health Center Sites...see https://keysahec.org/locations
