Mr. Flanigan's Aeronautical Engineering class were able to use the Aery-32 design software and design their own gliders within the parameters given. Once the parameters were met, they then built the gliders out of balsa and basswood. Next was on to test flights and adjustments. After waiting for a calm day to fly, they were able to launch the gliders with rubber band assistance, testing their flight characteristics and length of travel. The students learned a great deal about glider design, flight characteristics, and how to adjust them to improve their flights. This information will be used as the basis for their next section of learning Flight Navigation and Flight Simulations.

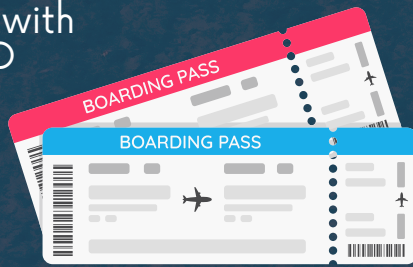
