


Principles of Biomedical Science classes learned a valuable clinical skill:

modeling a cross section view of the heart, followed by adding a heart to their Manikens.





Seniors in Mrs. Tara Jackson's Medical Lab Assisting class performed a blood typing lab today and used the results to determine suitable blood for transfusion.



Mrs. Tara Jackson's Human Body Systems students have been learning about indicators of cardiovascular health, including heart rate, blood

pressure, cardiac output calculations and ankle-brachial index. They got to practice listening and measuring brachial artery pressure using sphygmomanometers and doppler listening devices on each other.

Conch Pride accounts include free adult and teen online & mobile financial education programs that teach them how to save and manage their checking account and credit history and more.

Who can get a Conch Pride Checking Account?

Conch Pride Checking Accounts and Debit Cards are perfect for KWHS students- 14 years and older, parents, teachers, staff, alumni, and fans-that live or work in the Florida Keys.

Where can you open a Conch Pride account?


