Important Test Information

AP Tests:

Students who have their own transportation can come to school only for their AP test that is scheduled that day. Students taking morning tests (AM) can take the bus to school and if they have their own transportation can leave once the test is complete. If students need to take the bus home they must attend the rest of their classes that day. Students taking afternoon AP tests (PM) can come in only for the test can come in at 11:30 if they have their own transportation, if they have to ride the bus to school they must attend classes leading up to the AP test. There is NO transportation provided following afternoon AP tests. Students must have a ride home.

EOC and FAST Tests:

Students should come to school with a fully charged Chromebook and charger. Students who are taking an EOC or FAST ELA test are expected to attend a regular full day of school. Students are not permitted to leave school early after taking an EOC or FAST test.

Senior Exams:

Seniors last full day of school is May 13th. They will attend classes for periods 1-7 and then take their 7th period exam. For all other exams seniors will only report to school during the time of their exams.


Underclass Exams:

Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) & Computer Adaptive Testing (CAT)

Parent Info

What is CAT?

- Online assessment that is adjustable based on student answers
- Grade level content only (does not go above or below current grade level)
- PMS Testing Dates: Writing 4/1-4/12, FAST ELA , Math and Science 5/1-5/31

Which tests are CAT?

- FAST K-2
- FAST 3-10 ELA
- FAST 3-8 Math

- Algebra 1
- Geometry EOC
- 2024-2025 Science & Social Studies

How can I help my child?

- ✓ Access the FAST Family Portal to review PM1 and PM2 scores to set goals with your student. Each test picks up at the level the student left off at, encourage them to do their best on every test.
- ✓ Encourage them to do their best on every question before moving onto the next. This prevents the test from leveling down on the next question.
- ✓ Encourage students by saying, "The harder it gets, the better you are doing!" The more success in challenging content will earn a higher scale score.
- ✓ Use scratch paper to keep notes and work out problems.
- ✓ Use resources at home such as IXL, FAST practice tests, etc.
- ✓ Visit the FAST Portal for additional information.
- ✓ Review Achievement Level Scores so that your child understands their progress:

HOW TO REGISTER:

GO TO KEYSSCHOOLS.COM

In the right-hand corner, click Parents. From the menu, select Parent Resources. Under Other Parent Resources, click [FOCUS Parent Portal Registration](#).
- 02

CREATING YOUR ACCOUNT

If you are creating an account for the first time, click the orange box that says "I DO NOT HAVE A FOCUS Parent Portal Account and would like to create one (even if my child is already enrolled)" link at the center of the page.
- 03

ENTER PARENT INFORMATION

Enter your First and Last Name exactly as it appears on your identification. Then enter your active email address and create a password.
- 04

LINK YOUR CHILD

You will now click "I would like to ADD A CHILD who is already enrolled" to link your child to your account. Enter your child's Student ID number (begins with 440000) and Birth Date for MM/DD/YY then click add student. Repeat these steps to add any other children.
- 05

FINISH

Once you have successfully added all desired children, click "I am FINISHED adding students. Please take me to the Portal."

*Note in the future you will need to use the username provided and the password you create to access your portal again.
