- Principal's Report – Christine Paul: Ready for a great year. All positions currently filled (teachers & paraprofessionals)
 - 2022 School Results: Rated a B school, which Ms. Paul is satisfied with due to the ever-changing COVID rules.
 - Strategic Plan: Be an A school
 - Goals for 2022-23:
 - Increase ELA learning gains
 - Increase positive school climate
 - Improve attendance
 - Engage in coaching
- School Counselor – Chris Willis:
 - Attendance: Difficult the past two years, so the goal is to improve this year to 95-97% daily attendance rate. Last year was 91% daily attendance rate, with 142 chronically absent. The goal for this year is to limit this to 50-52 chronically absent. There will be attendance incentives and interventions.
 - PBIS: reinforce the four “Be’s” and all positive behavior.
- Vice Principal's Report – Sarah Adams:
 - iBElieve: Started by teachers about 10 years ago to create a guide for behavioral expectations for students and teachers. It has been developed through teachers, students, parents, and other staff.
 - Be Safe, Be Responsible, Be Respectful, Be Ready to Learn, Be Empowered.
 - Progress monitoring: Will take a new shape this year, 75% less time testing. Will be done throughout the year, instead of end of year testing.

 - >50% of students receive free/reduced breakfast and lunch
 - Meal Benefits Application: Applications need to be filled out for the current school year. They are accessible through the Switlik website and the Dojo app.
