They are free checking accounts with Conch debit cards help raise money up to \$1,000 per month for Key West High School. Keys FCU donates:

\$5 to KWHS for each account opened.

How can KWHS raise more money?

- Send flyer out in weekly newsletter and Peach jar email service
- Hang posters and banners in school/visible areas

Partner with Keys FCU to promote account openings at school events like open house, <u>orientation</u>, <u>college</u> fairs, graduation, sports events, meet the teacher

- Identify promotional/sponsorship opportunities on school materials/areas
- Circulate donation photos and information

Almost 700 students, most from 11th and 12 grade, attended the Annual College Fair at Key West High School held in the Gymnasium.

The college fair is organized by college and career counselor Mrs. Lydia Estenoz. This year, the fair included 34 universities and colleges as well as local law-enforcement agencies and Fire Academy representatives. Students spoke with admissions specialists from various universities and state colleges as well as military recruiters and academy officers.

Top trending schools attracting Conch graduates over the last couple of years include Florida State University, Florida Atlantic University, University of Florida, University of Central Florida and College of the Florida Keys.

Students were on their best behavior as they visited the booths, browsed college brochures, picked up promo goodies and inquired about admission requirements and scholarships.

"Today is not only an exciting day, but an important one as well. Seeing all the colleges in one room and engaging them is step one to imagining yourself in college." It's often the catalyst to applying for college," said Mrs. Estenoz




