COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAM

The purpose of the high school community service program is to encourage students to undertake volunteer activities in Monroe County. This program can enhance awareness of community problems and engage students in becoming agents of change. Community service is defined as volunteer hours donated to a selected organization that is non-profit in nature. Students give back to the community by sharing their talents, time and resources. Moreover, completion of minimum numbers of service hours is one requirement of the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program as well as of other scholarships.

COMMUNITY SERVICE CONDITIONS

- The service must meet a community need
- Community service hours must be served outside of the regular school day
- Students may not receive academic credit for these hours
- Students may not be paid for these hours
- Work done to promote a particular religious or political viewpoint or for personal gain cannot count as community service hours for purposes of this program
- Trainings/workshops or meetings of any type are considered personal enrichment and may not be counted as community service hours. However when the training translates into a community project, the student may then submit the hours for the training as well as for the service activity performed as a result of the training.
- Service must be signed off by a supervisor, and that person cannot be a relative
- Community service forms must be returned to the high school CCAPs counselor in order to be entered as part of the student transcript
- Any activities that are in question may be reviewed by the CCAPs committee
- Court-ordered community service does not count for purposes of this program
