

Dear Parents of Gerald Adam's 21st Century student,

We are thrilled your child has the opportunity to join our 21st Century program. This program is funded by a federal grant. Due to it being funded by a federal grant and being completely free to our families, there are many requirements in order to maintain this opportunity. Students **MUST STAY** for the duration of the program, they may be picked up between 5:20 and 5:30---ONLY. Students that leave the program earlier than 5:20 will result in their dismissal from the program. This opportunity is only allotted 120 spots, therefore the want/need to attend the program is very high. Students may be replaced with others whom CAN STAY for the duration of the program. When we sent home the original application, pickup times were included, in order to make families aware of the strict rules. We took faith in our families understanding the rules once they signed the application, however, the rules are not being followed by many, therefore a dismissal of students is imminent.

If your child can only stay certain days until 5:30, those are the only days your child may participate. We are trying to be as flexible as possible and we are trying to reach as many students as allowed. Please help us in maintaining your child's attendance by following the set guidelines.

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday pick up is at 5:30, the bus also leaves at 5:30.

Fridays—THERE ARE NO BUSES AVAILABLE AFTER 21ST CENTURY. **Pick up is at 5:00 SHARP.** Late pickups will result in daycare fees (must be paid immediately). If fees are not paid your child is suspended from the program or your child will be replaced with another student needing our after school services.
